<b>National New Member Fee</b>	\$ 230.00
Includes national new member fee, sisterhood packet, certificate, membership card and pledge badge	
<b>Chapter New Member Fee – Fall Semester</b>	\$ 850.00
Includes chapter new member fee, new member retreat, initiated member badge and other expenses that apply only to new members during the first year	
<b>Chapter New Member Fee – Spring Semester</b>	\$ 350.00
Includes gifts for little sisters who join the following fall	
<b>Meals</b>	\$1850.00
Includes 3 meals plus snacks each day Monday through Thursday and 2 meals plus snacks on Friday and the snack kitchen is open through the weekend	
<b>Room Rent</b>	\$4400.00
Covers room and all utilities	
<b>Parlor Fee</b>	\$ 550.00
Covers overhead for the facilities	
<b>House Fund</b>	\$ 300.00
Provide capital funding for house maintenance and renovation	
<b>Security</b>	\$ 190.50
Covers security personnel during evening hours and other times as needed and maintenance of house security systems	
<b>National Dues</b>	\$ 107.50
Covers per capita dues, communication fee and national insurance fee	
<b>Chapter Dues</b>	\$ 550.00
Covers educational, philanthropic and social activities of the chapter	
Total for active members in house each semester	\$7398.00
Total for active members not housed each semester	\$3548.00
Total for new members fall semester	\$4628.00
Total for new members spring semester	\$3898.00

**\*Alpha Chi Omega is one of the few sororities that use all-inclusive billing. Members will not be billed additional amounts for a badge, philanthropy events (\$5-20 each), sisterhood events \$5-25 each, bus transportation (\$50 or more each time), new member retreat (\$200-\$300), programming (\$5-\$50), etc. We have found that this ends up costing our members much less for these expenses. This is important to note when making cost comparisons. Our parents that experienced both methods have confirmed this.**
