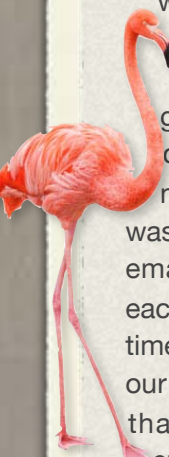


FAMILY NEWS
