



RHYTHM WORKSHOPS

Attending the Rhythm Workshop each Semester will aid in developing and strengthening the student's "inner rhythm clock" and will improve their instinct for the rhythms of their music. Any student who wants to learn "formal theory & technique" should attend.



Each Rhythm Workshop will involve "rhythm analysis". There will be ...

- ♪ **"Meter Study"** in which the students learn to identify & analyze the different meters of rhythm, such as Simple Duple Time and Compound Duple Time,
- ♪ **"Tempo Study"** in which the students learn to identify & analyze the different ways that speed affects the rhythm in a song,
- ♪ and **"Rhythmic Study"** in which the students learn to identify & analyze the rhythm patterns found in songs.

Each Rhythm Workshop will also involve "rhythm ear-training". There will be ...

- ♪ **"Clapping & Counting"** games & activities in which the students strengthen their abilities with Melodic & Harmonic Rhythm patterns,



- ♪ **"Rhythmic Dictation"** in which the students learn to identify & write out the rhythms that they hear,
- ♪ **"Rhythm Ensembles"** in which the students learn to play different rhythms at the same time to create one rhythmic pattern as a team,

We will also have a lot of fun practicing Rhythms using a wide variety of rhythm & percussion instruments (drums, tambourines, bells, cymbals, guiros, etc).

The classes are held at Hegarty Piano Studio. Fresh fruit and water is provided as a snack.
