We are seeking a competent legal professional to assist in the provision of legal services and in the development of all policies in the Pensions and Insurance regulatory areas within our General Counsel Division. This position will be located in our Fredericton office.

As Legal Counsel, you will research and prepare memoranda to the Commission concerning legislative and regulatory proposals and formulate recommendations for legislative changes to support departmental initiatives. You will confer with offices of the Superintendents of Pensions and Insurance in all other provinces, the federal insurance and pension regulator (OSFI), industry officials at a senior level, and industry associations on matters affecting the pensions and insurance industries as well as make recommendations for the development of regulatory policies and procedures in the insurance and pension division. This position will advise on the interpretation and application of the *Pensions Benefits Act*, the *Nursing Home Pension Plans Act*, the *Insurance Act*, the *Premium Tax Act*, and the *Special Insurance Companies Act* and help identify areas in need of reform. This position reports directly to the Associate General Counsel.

- 5 + years related legal experience;
- A minimum of three of these years should be pension or insurance industry related;
- Knowledge of the Pensions and Insurance industry and its practices and workings of government generally;
- Independent decision making;
- Ability to provide in-depth analysis of issues;
