

Hall of Chapters

Nebraska State FFA Convention

The Hall of Chapters display will be a featured event during the Nebraska State FFA Convention. Chapters registered to set up a display will receive set up location information following the close of the convention registration. All displays will be exhibited in Pinnacle Bank Arena on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of convention. Displays should be set by 4:00pm on Wednesday and removed no earlier than 4:00pm on Friday.

Displays will be scored according to the rubric below. The winning chapter will be asked to represent the Nebraska FFA Association at the Hall of States at National Convention following the annual state convention.

All displays will adhere to the following guidelines:

- A table space of three feet with a depth of approximately two feet will be provided. Displays must stay within their allotted area, if displays go outside of the area they will be disqualified.
- Tape, tacks or other harmful items **may not** be used to secure items to the tables.
- Displays must be free-standing **AND** placed on top of the table provided.
- Tables will remain where they are set up and will not be moved.
- Live animals are strictly prohibited, displays bringing live animals will be disqualified.
- If your display requires electricity it **MUST** be indicated when registering for the event. Failure to do this will result in no electrical outlet being provided.

Displays should feature information highlighting chapter accomplishments and special projects. Information should be displayed in a creative, clean and professional manner.

Chapters must register by purchasing a Hall of Chapters display space during the registration process.

General information about evaluation of displays

- Only registered chapters will be assigned a display location in the lobby of Pinnacle Bank Arena. See the convention schedule for set-up date and times. Assigned display location will be communicated to registered chapters within one week following the close of convention registration as well as posted on the State Convention page of the Nebraska Ag Ed website.
- Display evaluation will occur immediately following designated set-up times. Assigned evaluation times will be communicated to registered chapters within one week following the close of convention registration as well as posted on the State Convention page of the Nebraska Ag Ed website.
- Members should prepare a presentation not to exceed 3 minutes in length. No minimum length requirement for presentations. Presentations will be stopped by evaluators at 3 minutes. No additional visual aids may be used, other than the display, during the presentation.
- Members should be prepared to answer questions from the evaluators which will not exceed 3 minutes following the prepared presentation.
