

Parent Agreement

Calvary Christian School ~ 7-12th Grades

The purpose of Calvary Christian School is to teach academics and the Truth of God's Word in an environment where young people can receive that Truth and learn how to apply it wisely to their lives.

CCS is a direct extension of the Christian home and church. In order to function Scripturally CCS must provide a continuity of training for Christian young people. Therefore every effort is made to insure that CCS teachers, textbooks, extracurricular activities, rules and enforcement, enrollment policies, etc. are true to principles taught in God's Word (the Bible).

All Calvary teachers strive to obey God's command to ... "Train up a child in the way he should go ..." and ... "bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord." (Pro. 22:6, Eph. 6:4) Students are taught often and in many ways to give careful attention to God's instructions ... "Cease my son to hear the instruction that causeth thee to err from the words of knowledge," and ... "learn not the way of the heathen." (Pro. 19:27, Jer. 10:2)

Through direct teaching and a controlled school environment, we endeavor to continually teach our students that ... "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge." (Pro. 1:7)

1. _____ **Contract:** We understand that this agreement will function as a binding contract with CCS.
2. _____ **Parent/Student Handbook:** We have fully read the Parent/Student Handbook.
3. _____ **Handbook Compliance:** We will carefully support all programs, standards, regulations, and discipline as described in the CCS Parent/Student Handbook or implemented by the school.
4. _____ **Cooperation:** We pledge our willing cooperation with all CCS policies, procedures and rules and we will encourage our child(ren) to do the same.
5. _____ **Doctrine:** We have read the CCS Statement of Faith, we understand that our child(ren) will be taught Bible truth in harmony with that Statement, and we will support and not contradict these teachings.
6. _____ **Baptist Focus:** We understand that doctrine, principles of life, standards of behavior, etc. will be taught from Scriptures as held by fundamental Baptist churches throughout history, and as taught by Calvary Baptist Church.
7. _____ **Church Attendance:** We understand that eligibility for continued enrollment at CCS requires that our student and at least one parent maintain church membership and faithful attendance.

8. _____ **Pastoral Recommendation Required:** We understand that all families with students enrolled in 7-12th grades in Calvary must be approved for enrollment on the basis of recommendation given by the pastor of their attending church. (Recommendation form provided by CCS.)
9. _____ **Whole Child Education:** We understand that CCS will administer a complete education to our child in all areas (spiritual, academic, physical, social) as directed by God's Word.
10. _____ **Student Attitude & Behavior:** We accept responsibility for our child's attitude toward and willingness to obey all persons in authority at CCS. We will work cooperatively with the teacher in solving attitude and behavior problems.
11. _____ **When Parents Must Come:** If all usual school and home disciplinary measures fail, I will make myself available to come to school during the day to administer discipline to my child.
12. _____ **Program Changes:** We understand that CCS cannot change policies, procedures, curriculum, etc. to accommodate the special needs or desires of a few.

13. _____ **Mandatory Withdrawal:** We understand that our child will not be allowed to remain at CCS if he/she shows continued ... 1) aggression toward other students, 2) disobedience, 3) disrespect, 4) offensive language or actions, 5) disruptive behavior, 6) disrespect for the spiritual values of CCS, 7) etc.
14. _____ **Spreading Contrary Doctrine not Allowed:** We understand that if any 7-12th grade student voices opinions contrary to Baptist doctrine or our church and school's Statement of Faith, whether on or off property, he/she may be asked not to return the following year or may be dismissed from school during the current year. We further understand that arguing against a teacher about doctrine or any area of our Statement of Faith will be grounds for immediate dismissal.
15. _____ **Media Corruption:** We recognize and accept our responsibility to guard our children against the influence of any shows, movies, videos, etc. that promote profane or immoral activities or language, or excessively violent behavior.
16. _____ **Attendance Matters:** We pledge to carefully control matters of school attendance. Our child will be faithfully present and on time each day, unless providentially hindered. (attendance limits: 7-8th grades = 20 days per year; 9-12th grades = 10 days per semester)
17. _____ **Financial Obligation: We will pay all financial obligations on or before the due date** (tuition, fees, late stay, etc). We understand ... 1) that unpaid accounts become delinquent on the 1st business day after the 10th of each month, 2) that a \$10 late charge is imposed for each delinquent month, 3) that if an account becomes 60 days past due our child(ren) will not be allowed to attend classes until the account is settled, 4) that at the end of the year no records, report cards, diplomas, or transcripts will be issued until the account is paid in full, and 5) an account with an outstanding balance remaining after a family has withdrawn from CCS will incur a late fee each month equal to 1.5% of the outstanding balance until paid in full. We understand that these policies must be maintained to insure the financial stability of the school, and that a meeting of the school committee can be requested if there are unusual circumstances requiring special arrangements. We understand that only the school committee can approve special arrangements.
18. _____ **Permission Granted:** We give permission for our child to take part in activities sponsored by CCS, including field trips, athletic events, etc., away from the school premises. We absolve the school from liability due to any injury to our child at school or during a school activity. We give permission for emergency medical treatment to be administered in event of accident or illness.
19. _____ **Conflict Resolution:** If a problem concerning a classroom situation or school policy arises, we will always **contact the teacher first**, followed by other school officials as necessary (**not other parents**). We will **not criticize or gossip** about the school.

1. _____ **Handbook:** I have fully read the Parent/Student Handbook this year (or will have by the start of the coming school year). I understand that I am committing myself to follow its rules and policies.
2. _____ **Personal Choice:** I am enrolling of my own free will and by my personal choice. I realize that attending CCS is a privilege, not a right, and that attending CCS is a privilege that can be lost.
3. _____ **Respect:** I will at all times respect and obey authority without being critical.
4. _____ **Conduct:** At **NO time** will I **EVER** cheat, smoke, gamble, dance, use profanity, drink alcoholic beverages, use narcotics, or engage in illegal activities. I will maintain Christian standards of morality, honesty, kindness and courtesy. I will strive to demonstrate unquestionable Christian character in matters of conduct, dress, boy/girl relationships, etc.
5. _____ **Flag & Bible Pledges:** I do not object to saluting and pledging allegiance to the American and Christian flags and to the Bible.
6. _____ **Doctrine:** I will not in any way promote doctrinal beliefs, life practices, or political views that are contrary to those held by Calvary Baptist Church or Calvary Christian School.
7. _____ **Church Attendance Requirement:** I will commit to faithfully attending a Bible preaching church with a parent each week. I understand that failing to consistently live up to the church attendance requirement will disqualify me as a student of CCS. If I do not already have a track record of faithful attendance in another Bible preaching church, I will attend CBC.

12. _____ **BOYS' Hair:** With a good spirit, I will keep my hair ... 1) trimmed well above the shirt collar and ears, 2) tapered neatly on the back and sides, and 3) at least two finger widths above the eyebrows. Sideburns will be neatly trimmed to follow the natural hairline. I will not wear any hairstyle considered by CCS to be faddish or worldly.
13. _____ **GIRLS' Hair:** With a good spirit, I will dress in a way that is considered by CCS to be unquestionably modest. I will carefully follow every detail of the dress code as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook.
