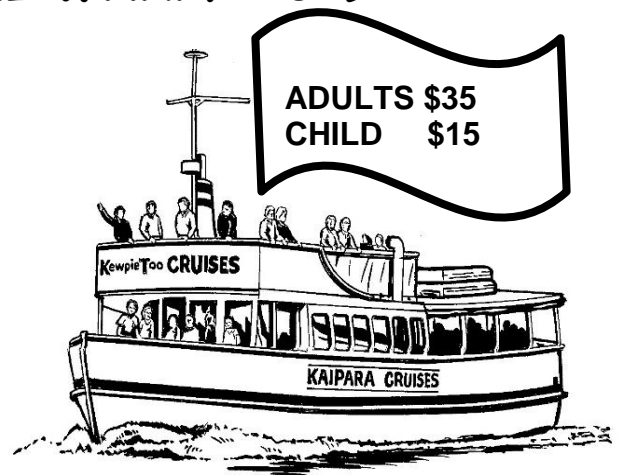

HOW TO GET TO PAHI

Pahi is approx 1 hr South of Whangarei
City. From Whangarei proceed S.H.1
approx 6km right onto Mangapai Rd,
3km into Paparua Rd, continue through
to Paparua-Oakleigh Rd to the town of
Paparua, turn Right, continue past the
Hotel just left is Pahi Rd, follow to end
of Rd. Plenty of free parking, boat
leaves from Pahi Wharf.
