Once your school has a NTHS Chapter, then submitting members is easy. The one-time fee is \$25 and students receive the following benefits:

- NTHS member certificate, presentation folder, general letter of recommendation for the student's portfolio, pin, membership card, window decal, white graduation tassel and official NTHS diploma seal
- **Scholarship Opportunities**
- Three letters of recommendation for potential employers, school admissions, and scholarship committees.
- Access to **NTHS Online Career Center** and **American Careers Journal**.
- Opportunities to purchase official NTHS commencement accessories and logo gear.
- NTHS Conferences and professional development opportunities.

Students are considered active members as long as they are enrolled in classes offered by their charter institution. Student candidates must meet national and local membership standards.
