

It is very important to know the catchment area because of the huge amount of development that has and will continue to take place on the west side. All that development adds to the sewage that flows to the plant.

- Catchment area starts at Bank Street (Bank Street is 8 blocks south of West 13th Street near the Hudson River.)
- From Bank Street, East to the West side of 6th Avenue.
- The three blocks to West 14th Street.
- On West 14th Street, east to the East Side of Union Square.
- Then down Broadway to 32nd Street
- Go east on 32nd Street to Fifth Avenue
- Up Fifth Avenue to 53rd Street.
- Go west to Broadway
- Then go to Columbus Circle (59<sup>th</sup> Street)
- From Columbus Circle, go north to Central Park West and 69th Street
- From 69th Street and Central Park West, go north to 105th Street
- From 105th Street and Central Park West, go due west to 8th Avenue (Frederick Douglass Blvd.)
- Up Frederick Douglass Blvd. to 121st Street.
- Go east on 121st Street to Malcolm X Blvd. (Lenox Avenue)
- On Malcolm X Blvd., go north to 137th Street.
- Then go west on 137th Street to Amsterdam Avenue
- Then go north on Amsterdam Ave. to 161st Street & St. Nicholas Avenue.
- Go straight up to Spuyten Duivil (the northern Manhattan) which is the end of catchment area.
