PHILOSOPHY STATEMENT

God's Word is the foundation for Temple Baptist Academy's philosophy. We cooperatively assist parents in fulfilling their God-given responsibilities to train up their children. As a ministry of Temple Baptist Church, we seek to teach and reinforce the basic truths of God's Word, promote Christian living, service, and high academic achievement. Every subject, activity, and program at Temple Baptist Academy is focused toward achieving these objectives.

At Temple Baptist Academy, we offer a thoroughly Christian program of education. Every subject gives preeminence to Jesus Christ and His salvation by grace through faith. Bible principles are thoroughly integrated into each class so the student can recognize the glory of God's creation and the practical application of godly living. We strive to develop Christian character in each child by emphasizing the practice of Bible principles in one's life. Mastery of basic subject matter is a primary goal, but developing critical thinking and reasoning skills is also important, thus equipping the child for advanced education and enabling him to live a more abundant life.

At the heart of character training are the godly principles of obedience and submission to authority. Obedience cultivates an inner self-discipline and is essential to the emotional, physical, social and spiritual well-being of every child. Discipline is administered fairly and firmly. Measuring one's actions and attitudes by scriptural principles is instilled in the students, which prepares them for their future.

We believe a Christian education should be God-centered and Christ-honoring. Therefore, we reject so called "Progressive" and "Traditional" forms of education because of their foundation in humanism. Though many parents and educators desire a return to the basics of education, Christianity cannot be added to a secular, humanistic, traditional public school curriculum and the result be called Christian education. Our curriculum is designed Christian from the ground up, and centers upon God and His Word. It stresses Biblical principles, Christian living, and American patriotism. We stand without apology for God and His mandate to raise our children according to His Word, as preserved in the King James Version.

BEHAVIORAL REQUIREMENTS

Temple Baptist Academy does not discriminate on the basis of race, gender, color, or national/ethnic origin in its admission policy. As a religious, private institution, however, it does screen students on the basis of academic ability, deportment, and compatibility with the school's religious goals, purpose and philosophy.

Students found to be out of harmony with this school's ideals of work and life may be invited to withdraw whenever the administration determines that it is necessary.

DRESS REQUIREMENTS

The Bible is clear that belief affects behavior. We believe that attitude and attire go hand-in-hand; that the appearance of students in this school should not bring reproach to the name of Jesus Christ. Therefore, clothing that is immodest, sensual, "weird," or in any other way expresses an unsavory message or attracts undue attention is not acceptable. In addition to dress requirements, students should arrive for school clean and well-kept. The following guidelines apply:

Classroom

Girls Dresses or skirts with blouses. Modest dresses and skirts must reach below the knee with no slits above the knee. Dress and blouse necklines must not be below three (3) finger's width from the collar bone. T-shirts, denim clothes, suspenders, sleeveless or tight blouses, sweat shirts, and pants of any kind are inappropriate for school. Girls should wear dress or conservative casual shoes which cover the foot (no sandals); no tennis shoes or hiking boots.

Boys Collared-shirt and tie (no string ties) with conservative slacks. Sweat shirts, jeans or other denim clothes are inappropriate for school. Dark colored dress or casual shoes are required for class; no sandals.

P.E. Dress:

Girls: Culottes or basketball shorts (below the knee), loose fitting top with no offensive slogans or designs, and gym shoes with socks

Boys: Loose fitting clothing: jeans or sweat pants, shorts to the knee, t-shirts with no offensive designs, and gym shoes with socks

Personal grooming should accompany attire:

Boys will maintain a conservative haircut (no bowl cuts or other fad haircuts) with hair kept off the ears and collar; combed away from the forehead. Bangs, mustaches, and beards are not allowed. Sideburns will not extend past the middle of the ear.

Girls in the 9th through 12th grade may wear modest make-up. Girls' make-up should be moderate and not draw undue attention. This holds true for hairstyles, nail polish, and jewelry.
