

NBAOT Fees and Documentation for Renewal

(Cheques can be made payable to the New Brunswick Association of Occupational Therapists)

NBAOT regulations state that all members of NBAOT must also be members of

a. The Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists (CAOT)

or

b. L'Ordre des Ergothérapeutes du Québec (OEQ) prior to February 1, 1989
and have maintained this membership.

As well, members must have worked using occupational therapy skills for at least 1000 hours within the five years immediately preceding renewal in the provision of direct services, education, consultation, administration or other professional endeavors related to Occupational Therapy.

Individual Membership

This membership is for Occupational Therapists who wish to practice on a full-time or part-time basis.

Provisional Membership

This membership is for members waiting to write the national examination. Provisional registration may be granted for up to 18 months.

Temporary Membership

This is a membership granted for up to 6 months to applicants who are:

- hired to work in New Brunswick for a period not exceeding 6 months, OR**
- taking parental leave within 6 months of April 1**
