Sydney Classic & Antique Truck Show (SCAATS 2017)

Held at Museum of Fire, (Reg Charity) 1 Museum Drive, Penrith

Show Day Sunday 28th May 2017, Saturday 27th May arrival and setup

This event is open to all veteran, vintage and classic Trucks & Buses, Utes, Vans, Military & Fire vehicles or any other historic vehicle permitted by the organisers that is 30 years or over. This show is held to promote the collecting, conserving and the restoration of heavy vehicles.

Pre entry is required, entries will close at a time and date determined by organisers dependent on number & size of entries. An entry form for each vehicle must be submitted with payment of \$30. This fee will include amenities e.g. showers and 2 adult passes (wrist bands) for Sat/Sunday admission and issue of 2 show badge. Passes will allow free rides & entertainment. Also includes entry to Museum Sat & Sunday and any other organised events or activities at the Show.

This is nonrefundable fee. Wrist bands will be issued on arrival Saturday.

The Show will consist of Saturday 27th May 2017 arrival, set up & Saturday Night Meal

Join with us in making this a memorable ongoing annual show. Constructive suggestions are welcome.

- There will be no Mulgoa Rumble this year.
- The show area will be fenced off and not accessible to public on Saturday. Only entrants (2 Adult passes) and approved workers & support people verified prior to the weekend by the organizer, will be Permitted. All people that form part of this group will be required to wear identifying wrist bands for the weekend and a separate band for Saturday night meal. Removal of bands will void entry and supply of meal.
- Saturday Night will consist of a Meal & get together. The meal will be a general roast & salads at a cost of \$15 per head. **Booking & payment essential before weekend.**
- Arrival preferred on Saturday to allow setup or must arrive before 7.30am Sunday. No vehicle will be permitted entry to the show after 7.30am Sunday. Free on-site camping registered exhibitors of vehicles and approved persons only. No guarantee of powered sites. Camping will be restricted to basic needs. Sites limited to manageable numbers. Caravan Parks and other accommodation are available in Penrith.
- Unloading ramps and facilities will be available if required and crewed by Organising Officials.
- There will be no parking on site during show day; all parking will be off site and in designated areas.
- Non show vehicles must be moved before 7.30am on Sunday to the general visitor parking area.
- Displays, activities and demonstrations by entrants are encouraged but must be pre organised & approved to allow space and support.
- No dogs allowed anytime unless a certified carers dog with accompanying papers.

Show Day Sunday 28th May 2017

The event will be open for public display from 8am until 3pm. Public Adult entry \$15.00.

(Up to 3 Children less than 16 Free permitted with each paying Adult). Concession \$10 (no children)
(No dogs allowed anytime unless a certified carers dog with accompanying papers, no alcohol on show day)

- 1. All vehicles that are driven on site must be registered or on a suitable permit and driven by a fully licensed driver appropriate to the vehicle who shall comply with the current provisions of the Motor Traffic Act and all directions of the Organizers. All driven vehicles must be insured to cover any third party personal injury or third party property damage. In most cases Public Liability will not accept Liability caused by or arising out of the use of or ownership or operation by You of any Vehicle which is legally required to be registered or/ and insured.*
- 2. All Participants and visitors must abide by any direction given by the Organising Committee and/or relevant statutory Authorities in relation to risk management and all aspects of safety. Vehicles must not be moved during the period open to Public display. Entrants acknowledge that the speed limit on the grounds is restricted to 10KPH.*
- 3. The organizers reserve the right to restrict the number of entries for any reason.*
- 4. All entrants must obey the directions of event officials and their agents at all times, and must conduct themselves in an Orderly manner. The organizers reserve the right to refuse or terminate any entry at any time and/or for any reason.*
- 5. Entrants will park in the space/area allocated allowing sufficient space for other vehicles to park in adjoining areas and without hindrance to the access or egress or that of the spectators and the general public.*
- 6. Entrants authorise organizers to film photograph or reproduce in any medium the entrants vehicles used in the event, and shall have the free and unrestricted right to use entrant's names and or such reproductions in promotion of the event.*
- 7. As set down by our public liability insurer and risk management – no display vehicle is to leave or move from its Position before 3pm on Sunday 28th May 2017. If an emergency arises causing an entrant to leave, the organizers will to the best of their ability secure the vehicle & property of the entrant for later pickup at an appropriate time & day.*
- 8. In consideration for the right to participate in the Sydney Classic & Antique Truck Show by acceptance of this form You release and discharge to the full extent permitted by the law, The Museum of Fire, Pioneer Timber Cutters & Machinery Club, The Western Sydney Truck Club, the Organising Committee and their officers, agents, employees, representatives and anyone else connected with the Sydney Classic & Antique Show from any known or unknown damages, injuries, losses, judgments and/or to his or her property. Frequently Asked Questions

Thanks for your questions, I will supply answers between your questions.

1. Could you give more information about the loading ramps and facilities please ?

a) Location and distance from the display site.

Answer - The ramps will be located within the Museum property, the exact location will be determined on number of entries, we are expecting many more than last year. But understand that we place a high priority on servicing our major supporters (Entrants) all facilities will be within easy access.

b) Approx. heights and quality of loading ramps

Answer - Ramps will be hydraulic & adjustable to suit.

c) Any other info you may have as regards for vehicle loading/unloading.

Answer - clearly indicate what support you need on application or attach another sheet. Re leaving trailers in storage etc.

2. Saturday Mulgoa Rumble

There will be no Mulgoa Rumble this year.

3. Is the \$30 entry fee payable for vehicles loaded and left on the back of antique trucks (and or trailers) or just payable for the hauling vehicle?

Answer the discussion for this year is you may

- a) Charge - enter the vehicle and receive two addition entry tickets and medallion & badge (value close to \$70).
- b) No Charge - Not enter the vehicle, leave it on back of vehicle and receive no tickets nor medallions etc. for that vehicle however.
- c) Charge - If the vehicle on the back is displayed for sale or promotion then entry will be required.

4. As regards to approved workers and support people?

Is there any problems with any of our members children being on site during the Saturday set up? (the children will be strictly supervised by us.)

Answer There is no problem with children on the site Saturday providing they are genuine members of the immediate family of the entrants and remain under their immediate supervision. This is only so we can keep things safe for all during vehicle movements and setup. Saturday is designed for Participants to communicate with each other without the lookers.

Please remember we are very experience organizes, we greatly appreciate your participation and we are determined to run this as a friendly professional show that meets all the compliance issues required. We will try and deliver better facilities to participants each year and more entertainment to draw the crowds to encourage new people into collecting and restoring. We welcome your CONSTRUCTIVE criticism.
