NATIVE AMERICAN SUNDAY!

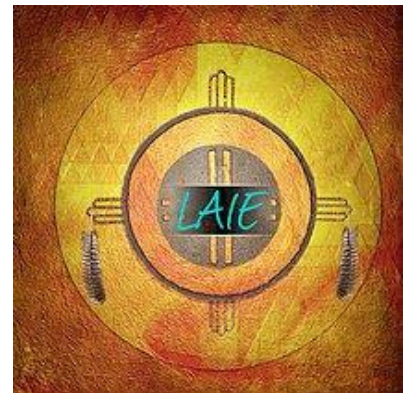
**Cedarville Band of Piscataway Indians
