The NIV has a **REALLY** interesting translation of 2 Timothy 3:15.

Have you ever noticed?

*“From **infancy** you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.”*

(Paul is writing to Timothy)

Paul was reminding Timothy of something that is today very vital and totally relevant to Heritage Baptist. He said, “Timothy, you have known the Holy Scriptures since your *infancy*.” Not from his “youth” or his “childhood”. But from his *infancy*. That's about as young as it gets! Timothy sure wasn't reading the Scriptures for himself at that age. Someone else was doing that for him. Someone who believed in the limitless power of our limitless God to penetrate with His life-changing Word the hearts and minds of even the tiniest and least mature of those He has created in His own image.

“If you are holding a precious baby, if you are chasing a toddler, if you are teaching a preschooler or early elementary child, then you have the privilege of helping shape a life for eternity! These are the formative years, the ones when the message of the gospel can most easily take hold. We want children to learn the Bible ... and we cannot begin teaching it too soon.” – Jean Thomason
