- Worksafe high risk licenses including, EWP, forklift, Confined space, Working at Heights.
- Intermediate computer skills & willingness to learn production monitoring programs.

Desirable for this role:

- Pressure welding certificate or willing to obtain relevant certificates.
- Experience in food grade stainless steel Tig welding.
- First Aid certificate.
- Hydraulic and electrical knowledge.

- Have a willingness to lead by identifying areas of improvement and to bring them forward for discussion to improve all areas of plant performance.
