Beginner Rider:	Rider 12 or under.....	W/J
Amateur Rider:	Rider any age.....	W/J
*Green Horse:	Horse is new to showing .....	W/J
*Ranch Horse:	Open - any age.....	WJL
Junior Rider:	Rider is 18 or under.....	WJL
Senior Rider:	Rider is 19 or older.....	WJL

**Only One High Point Division Per Horse & Rider Combination  
Do not cross enter divisions - Please use open classes for extra practice**

**All Riders under 18 must wear an ASTM approved helmet, securely fastened, while mounted or otherwise handling a horse.**

**See show manager for problems and questions:**

1. Ribbons: First through sixth places.
2. Negative Coggins is required - there are no exceptions.
3. Judging based on SSBC, AQHA, USEF rules.
4. All ties are broken by the Horsemanship Class
5. All stallions must be handled by an adult (18 or older).
6. All riders must sign a SSBC "Waiver & Indemnity" Release form.
7. SSBC is not responsible for loss or injury to a horse, rider or property.
8. Required: Appropriate dress, boots, tack, and if under 18, an ASTM helmets.
9. Classes may be divided if entries warrant.
10. To qualify for end of day High Point, same horse and rider team is required to go in Showmanship, Pleasure and Horsemanship in their chosen division.
11. Trail and grooming are not required but do count toward high point for the day.
12. Please advise paddock master if dropping a class, one class prior to the dropped class.
13. An amateur is one who does not receive payment for training, lessons, etc.
14. \*A ranch horse is a working horse for which light contact and natural gaits are rewarded. We follow AQHA rules for Ranch Horse. See copy posted at registration
15. \*A green horse is one that has been showing for less than two years.
