The Microfilm copies of St. John County Probate Files are numbered 20 – 74 inclusive (16mm microfilm)

The “raison d’etre” of the Probate Courts is to determine the legitimacy of a will and oversee the execution of provisions of the will, where one exists. Where no will exists (i.e. the person died intestate), the court appoints the administrators to settle the estate by settling bills, collecting debts owed to the deceased, establishing the assets and liabilities and dividing the estate to the satisfaction of the court. The court also appoints guardians for infants and minors.

According to the Royal Instructions given to New Brunswick’s first administrator, Governor Thomas Carleton, in 1784, the Governor had jurisdiction in the Probate Court. Governor Carleton chose not to use this power. Instead he appointed Edward Winslow as Surrogate General in November 1784. Winslow was empowered to “make probate of all last wills and testaments ... also to grant letters of administration of all estates...of persons dying interstate”. (November 29, 1784 Instructions to Winslow). Winslow appointed Deputy Surrogates for each county except York, where he presided as the Judge of Probate.

William Hazen Jr. was appointed Surrogate General in 1807 upon the resignation of Edward Winslow. He held this position for at least 10 years. Hazen seems to have been the last person to act as Surrogate General. The practice of Surrogates with jurisdiction in Probate, being appointed by the Lieutenant Governor for each county, was begun in approximately 1817 and validated by legislation in 1840 (3 Vict. C61). In the 1840 legislation, the Chancery Court was given appellate jurisdiction for Probate Courts. The 1840 Act also legislated the appointment of a Registrar of Probate for each county to be responsible for the care and custody of the records of the Probate Court.

Following legislation passed in 1983 and made effective in May 1984, there is no longer a probate court in each county. Instead, the province has been divided into nine Judicial Districts, each having a probate court. Appeals of probate court rulings can be found in Records of Court of Appeal (Record Series 43) and Supreme Court: County Court and Special Appeals (Record Series 47). These record series are found at the Provincial Archives of New Brunswick.

CHURCHES

TRINITY ANGLICAN CHURCH Germain Street, Saint John, N. B.

The Loyalists chose the site of the Court House near the Old Loyalist Burial Ground to erect the first Episcopal Church in Saint John. When a fire swept the site in 1784, they opted to erect a place of worship on Germain Street. On August 20th, 1788, the corner stone of "Old Trinity" was laid. On Christmas Day, 1791, the first service was held at the new church. "Old Trinity" was swept away in the Great Fire of June 20th, 1877. The corner stone of the new Trinity Church was laid May 19th, 1879 and consecrated by the Lord Bishop of Fredericton Dec. 9th, 1880. Trinity Church is contained within the Diocese of Fredericton, as are other Anglican Churches in Saint John. It administers the ecclesiastical parish of Saint John.

Although the vestry minutes have survived since 1790, the Trinity Church records of births, marriages, and burials were destroyed when the dwelling of Rector Rev. Benjamin Gerrish Gray, D.D. was consumed by fire in November 1833. The original church records of Baptisms 1836 - 1901 and Burials 1839 - 1901 are believed to be in existence, but have not been microfilmed.

It existed as a separate church until 1917 when the congregation united with that of St. Stephen's church to form Knox Church which was subsequently renamed the Church of St. John and St. Stephen.

LORNEVILLE - SOUTH BAY UNITED CHURCH 1885 - 1990

The congregation of the Lorneville Presbyterian was organized in 1857 and their church building was dedicated in 1859. Due to the congregation's growth, a new building was dedicated in 1885. In 1925 the Lorneville Presbyterian congregation joined the newly formed United Church of Canada and became the Lorne Ville United Church.

The South Bay congregation was formed much later. On September 30, 1950, a community meeting to organize a church at South Bay was held in the auditorium of the South Bay school. On October 24, 1950, South Bay United Church was selected as the name for the new congregation. The old school building was purchased and renovated as a church building and a church hall was built and dedicated in 1958.

The congregation of Lorneville United Church agreed to share their minister with the new South Bay congregation and a new Pastoral Charge, the Lorneville South Bay Pastoral Charge was formed.

ST. ANDREWS AND ST. DAVID UNITED CHURCH

St. Andrew and St. David United Church is the result of the combination of three former churches in Saint John:

Calvin Presbyterian, formed 1855

St. Andrews Kirk, formed 1815

St. David's Kirk, formed 1849

Calvin Presbyterian formed 1855 on Hazen Street later moved to the corner of Wellington Row and Carleton Street. On May 1, 1918 their congregation amalgamated with St. Andrew's Kirk. The vacated church building later became the Shaarei Zedek Synagogue. The original St. Andrew's Kirk was built on Germain Street between Horsfield and Duke St. in 1815. It was destroyed June 20th, 1877 during the Great Saint John Fire. The new Kirk was built on the same site in 1878. In 1926 the Kirk was renamed St. Andrew's United.

The corner stone of the first St. David's Kirk was laid August 16, 1849. The building was located on Sydney Street between Princess and Duke Streets. It was also destroyed in the Great Saint John Fire June 20th, 1877 and rebuilt on the same site in 1878. The "new" building was destroyed in a subsequent fire in 1918 and the church was rebuilt. In 1926 it became St. David's United Church.

In January 1962, St. Andrew's United and St. David's United churches united with their congregations worshipping in the St. Andrew's Church.

St. John's (Stone) Anglican Church administers St. Mark's Ecclesiastical Parish and thereby is erroneously referred to in many documents as St. Mark's Church. When "Old Trinity" on Germain Street was unable to accommodate its growing congregation, the vestry decided to erect a chapel on a lot on Carleton Street donated by the Hon. Ward Chipman. Freestone was imported from England and the church was thereafter known as the "Stone Church." Rev. George Best conducted the first service on September 11th, 1824, and St. John's was consecrated by the Lord Bishop of Nova Scotia on July 16th, 1826. The Old Trinity Corporation continued to administer St. John's until 1853 when the parish of St. Mark's was established. One year later, part of its parishioners residing near Haymarket Square established a new Anglican church, St. Mary's, at the foot of Waterloo Street. St. John's (Stone) Church was untouched by the Great Saint John Fire of June 20th, 1877, and continues in use today (2002). (Daniel F. Johnson, *The New Brunswick Genealogist* Vol. 1 p. 2-3)

Apparently the books containing St. John's (Stone) records previous to 1852 were housed at Old Trinity on Germain Street and were destroyed in the Great Fire of 1877 - typed card attached to burial records G24, Item 5.

Centenary-Queen Square United Church is the result of the evolution of several former congregations in Saint John as follows:

- (1) Germain St. Methodist Chapel established in 1791 which, following the Great Fire of June 20, 1877 relocated to the western end of Queen Square North and became
- (2) Queen Square Methodist Church which, in 1925, became Queen Square United Church
- (3) Centenary Methodist Church established in 1839 which, in 1925, became Centenary United Church
- (4) In 1939 Queen Square United Church and Centenary United Church merged and adopted the name of Centenary-Queen Square United Church.
- (5) Carmarthen St. Methodist Church became Carmarthen St. United Church in 1925. It amalgamated with Centenary-Queen Square United Church in 1957.
