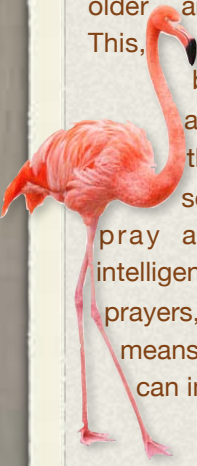

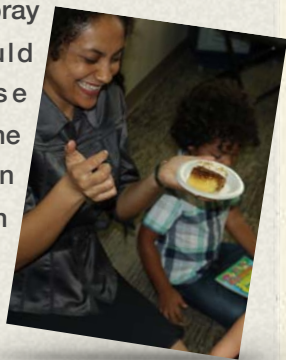


## MINISTRY NEWS
