Our bi-monthly Children's Fun Day was held at the end of September and we had a wonderful time teaching the children the importance of treasuring the right things in their life.

In October our church organized a special meeting to reach out to the Russian population in Neutraubling. Having a population of about 13,000, Neutraubling represents over 80 nationalities, with Russian being one of the predominate nationalities. In our church alone we have three Russians who attend faithfully. During our special meeting, the German-Russian Culture Day, we ate Russian food, sang hymns in both German and Russian, and one of our Russian ladies gave her testimony. It was a pleasure to have eight visitors, two of which were our landlord and his Russian wife!

At the end of October, Jackson celebrated his 8th birthday! He had a fun time with his buddies from school and church. We are thankful for all those who sent him cards of congratulations! It has been a joy to watch him grow into a little man.

Also in October, Bob spent a week in the States for his grandmother's funeral, who passed away at the age of 89. We were saddened, but rejoice, knowing we will see her again!

In our last letter we have shared how God has put us in contact with a Syrian refugee, Samer, who we have been helping since he arrived in Germany in June. We are praising the Lord for answered prayers, in that Samer has been given a visa and now his wife and three children are able to join him here in Germany! He is finally allowed to work and take German classes. Pray that he will quickly find a place of residence, a secure job, and learn German to help with his complete integration here in Germany. I have shared with him how many of you who read our letter pray for him. It greatly touched him and he is thankful for all those interceding on his behalf!

Since the end of September we have had Lauretta Kintop stay with us. She and her fiancé have a desire to minister in Germany in the future. She will be staying with us until December to help us with the church and learn about life in Germany. We are thankful for her help with the children and various ministries in the church.
