Investigator (contract position)

We are seeking an experienced Investigator to fill a two-year contract position for our Enforcement Division who will have the following responsibilities:

- Analysis and research of intelligence and complaints received.
- Investigation of potential violations of various financial and consumer protection laws.
- Assisting legal counsel in the preparation of case files for administrative and court action.
- Providing testimony before a tribunal or in court.
- Liaising with other regulatory and law enforcement agencies with respect to the investigation of matters, as required.
- Remain informed of current market and industry trends and issues in financial and consumer services.
- Occasionally contribute to the development of local and national policies and legislation related to enforcement matters.
- Frequent travel to conduct investigations.

The successful applicant will:

- Possess a good knowledge of, and training in, interviewing and investigative techniques with a minimum of three years related experience.
- Demonstrated adaptability and flexibility in relation to investigations.
- Demonstrated ability to lead complex financial investigations.
- Have a good knowledge of accounting principles and be able to read and understand financial statements and records.
- Have proficiency in both official languages.
- Demonstrated ability to write clear and effective investigative reports.
- Possess excellent verbal, written and interpersonal skills.
- Knowledge of financial services industries and capital markets is an asset.
- Have excellent organizational skills.
- Have proficiency using a computer as a document preparation, research and investigative tool.
- Work well in a team environment and independently with little supervision.
- Be inquisitive and analytical.
