HOUSE BILL NO. 263 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-11-67, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY CONDUCT THAT IS CONSIDERED BEING BULLYING BEHAVIOR; TO AMEND SECTION 37-11-69, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE PROVISIONS TO BE INCLUDED IN A SCHOOL DISTRICTS' ANTI-BULLYING POLICIES; TO REQUIRE SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO POST THE PROPER PROCEDURE FOR REPORTING BULLYING ON THEIR INTERNET WEBSITE; TO AMEND SECTIONS 37-3-101 AND 37-3-103, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO ADOPT A POLICY ON STUDENT SUICIDE PREVENTION, TO PRESCRIBE STANDARDS FOR THE REQUIRED POLICY 9 10 AND TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH TO DEVELOP IN-SERVICE TRAINING 11 STANDARDS FOR SUICIDE PREVENTION EDUCATION; AND FOR RELATED 12 13 PURPOSES. 14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 15 SECTION 1. Section 37-11-67, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 16 amended as follows: 37-11-67. (1) As used in this section, "bullying or 17 18 harassing behavior" is any pattern of gestures or written, 19 electronic or verbal communications, or any physical act or any 20 threatening communication, or any act reasonably perceived as 21 being motivated by any actual or perceived differentiating 22 characteristic, that takes place on school property, at any

school-sponsored function, or on a school bus, and that:

- (b) Creates or is certain to create a hostile 27 environment by substantially interfering with or impairing a 28 student's educational performance, opportunities or benefits. For 29 purposes of this section, "hostile environment" means that the 30 victim subjectively views the conduct as bullying or harassing 31 behavior and the conduct is objectively severe or pervasive enough 32 that a reasonable person would agree that it is bullying or 33 34 harassing behavior.
- 35 (2) No student or school employee shall be subjected to 36 bullying or harassing behavior by school employees or students.
- 37 (3) No person shall engage in any act of reprisal or 38 retaliation against a victim, witness or a person with reliable 39 information about an act of bullying or harassing behavior.
- 40 (4) A school employee who has witnessed or has reliable
 41 information that a student or school employee has been subject to
 42 any act of bullying or harassing behavior shall report the
 43 incident to the appropriate school official.
- (5) A student or volunteer who has witnessed or has reliable information that a student or school employee has been subject to any act of bullying or harassing behavior should report the incident to the appropriate school official.

51	SECTION 2. Section 37-11-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
52	amended as follows:

54	include in its personnel policies, discipline policies and code of
55	student conduct a prohibition against bullying or harassing
56	behavior and adopt procedures for reporting, investigating and
57	addressing such behavior, that:
58	(a) Prohibit the bullying of a student;
59	(b) Prohibit retaliation against any person, including
60	a victim, a witness, or another person, who in good faith provides
61	information concerning an incident of bullying;
62	(c) Establish a procedure for providing notice of an
63	incident of bullying to a parent or guardian of the victim and a
64	parent or guardian of the bully within a reasonable amount of time
65	after the incident;

67	obtain assistance and intervention in response to bullying;
