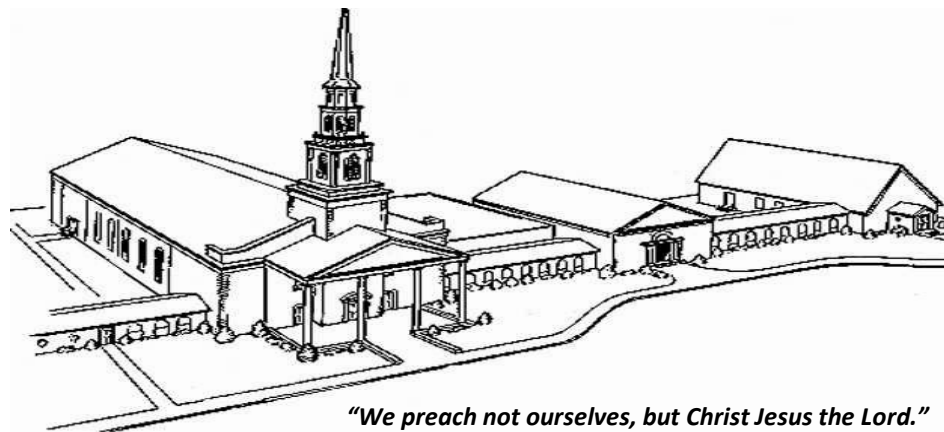

The supplies are for this summer's volunteer workers who are planning on coming in August. They will be stopping in Washington to get electrical supplies that were donated. They will be catching the ferry to Ketchikan and then another ferry to the Prince of Wales Island and then driving to Thorne Bay spending two days to unload, and fly home. They will leave the truck there to have for the summer work. Please pray for their safety and travel.

Soon after returning to Flagstaff, Sam is scheduled to be the English speaker at the Western Navajo Bible Fellowship family camp here in Flagstaff. This is always a good time of fellowshiping with other Believers, and we are looking forward to it. They have both morning and evening classes, so you can see that a lot of preparation is needed for the 8-day camp. Please pray for him, the Navajo speakers, and those working with the youth to be clear as God's Word is taught and that hearts will be challenged and encouraged.

Earlier this month, we received a visit from a Navajo lady who stopped to spend the night on her way to Phoenix. Lorena was one of our former Bible School students. After graduation, she taught in a small Christian school on the Reservation and later joined the local mission where she has been serving the Lord for over 20 years. We haven't had contact with her for many years. She wanted to stop and tell us thank you for the time spent in teaching and training her. What an encouragement to us to hear how God has used her and of her faithfulness over the years!
