## Are you having any of the following common financial concerns?

- I have trouble paying bills because they are confusing to me.
- I don't feel confident making big financial decisions alone.

- My children, or others around me, are pressuring me to give them money.
- People are calling me or mailing me asking for money.
- Someone is accessing my accounts. Money seems to be disappearing from them.
- Someone is cashing my pension, insurance or other cheques without permission.
- Someone has forced me to sign a power of attorney, sell my house or change my will.
