From the Pastor

“A Heart for God”

Each of us at some point in our life see ourselves in the life of David. His many psalms show the pouring out of his heart. Next to our Lord Jesus Christ, God devotes more chapters of His Word to David than any other person (some 54 chapters in all). His most outstanding quality was being a man after God’s own heart. From his days of youth, to the monarchy, and to his death we can examine him from all ages to see this quality.

Several months ago I began to study his life in depth to see what God would teach us about ourselves. This study developed into a series of 43 messages that God gave me on the life of David. As a result we will spend this year developing a greater heart for God. Although circumstances and troubles will still come, the person with a heart for God knows that He must still be the focus and purpose for life. We will examine David—his highlights and his lowlights. The purpose is to develop in our own lives a true heart for God.

Tonight I will begin a 12-week series of messages on “Surviving Stress.” So many individuals struggle through periods of stress not realizing God has a plan to use it in our lives as a tool of change and strengthening. So often we hear....

- ◆ “This is stressful.”

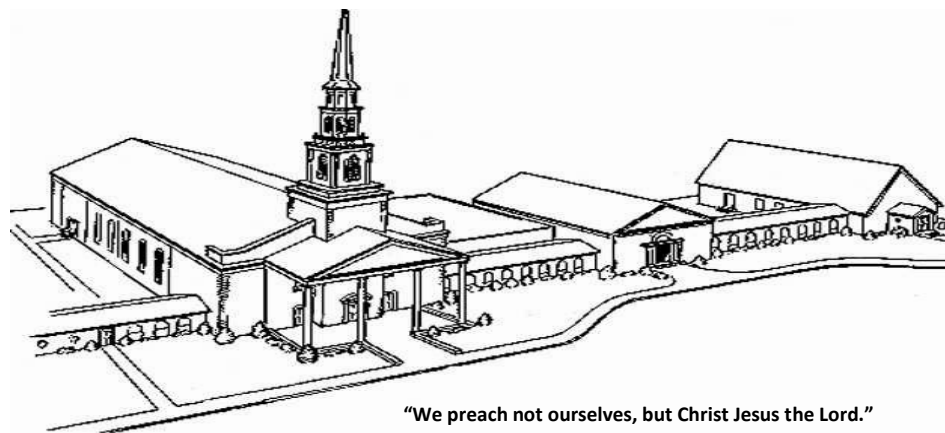
