CLUB HISTORY AND MISSION

WELCOME TO SILVER SANDS BRIDLE CLUB, INC. VOLUSIA COUNTY'S LARGEST EQUINE CLUB.

SSBC WAS FOUNDED IN 1948 KNOWN AS THE VOLUSIA COUNTY QUARTER RUNNING HORSE ASSOCIATION. THROUGHOUT THE YEARS THE CLUB HAS HAD MANY HOMES, BUT CURRENTLY THE CLUB IS LOCATED AT 625 TOMOKA FARMS RD., NEW SMYRNA BEACH, FLORIDA. THE MANAGEMENT OF THE CLUB'S FACILITY AND EVENTS ARE PERFORMED BY CLUB MEMBERS.

THE CLUBS PHILOSOPHY IS TO PROMOTE THE EQUESTRIAN SPORT THROUGH HORSE SHOWS, EDUCATIONAL CLINICS AND 4-H CLUBS.

CLUB MEETINGS ARE HELD THE LAST MONDAY OF EACH MONTH AT 7:30 PM. EXCEPTIONS TO THIS ARE IN, MAY THE LAST TUESDAY, AND IN DECEMBER THE CLUB MEETING IS COMBINED WITH THE CHRISTMAS PARTY.

MEMBERSHIP

JOINING THE CLUB: TO BECOME A MEMBER OF SSBC THE APPLYING MEMBER/FAMILY NEEDS TO SUBMIT A MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION ALONG WITH A NON-REFUNDIBLE APPLICATION FEE OF \$20.00. MEMBERSHIP IS ATTAINED AFTER THE APPLYING MEMBER ATTENDS THREE MONTHLY MEETINGS WITHIN SIX MONTHS, VOLUNTEERS AT THREE SSBC FUNCTIONS AND IS VOTED IN, AT THE TIME OF BEING VOTED IN PAYMENT OF DUES IS THEN REQUIRED.

THE APPLYING MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE IN CLINICS AND WORK AT SHOWS, WHEN MEMBERSHIP IS OBTAINED ***ALL OTHER MEMBER BENEFITS WILL BE EFFECTIVE.*** CREDIT FOR WORKING DURING THE APPLYING PERIOD WILL BE COUNTED TOWARDS THE CURRENT YEAR MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP STATUS BUT NOT TOWARDS YEAR END HIGH POINT AWARDS.

IF THE NEW MEMBER COMPLETES THEIR MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AFTER AUGUST 1ST THE ANNUAL DUES ARE REDUCED BY 50% \$12.50 FOR INDIVIDUALS AND \$25.00 FOR FAMILIES.

ALL MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO WORK DURING THE YEAR TO RETAIN THEIR MEMBERSHIP THE FOLLOWING YEAR. VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS ARE:

- 1) INDIVIDUAL MEMBER: THREE SEPARATE WORK FUNCTIONS.
- 2) FAMILY MEMBERSHIP CONSISTING OF TWO ADULTS: SIX SEPARATE WORK FUNCTIONS FROM ANY OF THE FAMILY MEMBERS.
- 3) FAMILY MEMBERSHIP CONSISTING OF ONE ADULT: THREE SEPARATE WORK FUNCTIONS FROM ANY FAMILY MEMBER.

THERE ARE THREE MEMBERSHIP TIERS:

INDIVIDUALS FOR THE SINGLE MEMBER 18 OR OLDER THE ANNUAL DUES ARE \$25.00
FAMILY FAMILIES CONSISTING OF TWO ADULTS OR PARENTS AND DEPENDENT CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 18 THE ANNUAL DUES ARE \$50.00.

WHEN THE DEPENDENT CHILD OBTAINS THE AGE OF 18 AN INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP OF THEIR OWN IS REQUIRED. THE YOUNG ADULT SHOULD COMPLETE AN APPLICATION AND PAY THE INDIVIDUAL DUES. APPLICATION FEE & MEETING ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS ARE WAIVED. IF THE CONVERSION IS IN THE LAST QUARTER OF THE YEAR THE FEE FOR DUES IS ALSO WAIVED.

EXHIBITION THE EXHIBITION MEMBER CLASSIFICATION IS FOR THOSE EXHIBITING PERSONS WHO CURRENTLY ARE NOT MEMBERS OF SSBC. EACH TIME AN INDIVIDUAL SHOWS AT A SSBC SHOW \$1.00 OF THE OFFICE FEE WILL BE CONSIDERED THE MEMBERSHIP FEE FOR THAT DAY. BENEFITS FOR EXHIBITION MEMBERS IS LIMITED TO ACCESS TO THE WEB SITE. AT THE END OF THE EXHIBITION DAY THE EXHIBITION MEMBERSHIP WILL EXPIRE.

RENEWAL DUES:

CLUB DUES ARE PAYABLE IN THE MONTH OF JANUARY. IT IS EACH MEMBERS RESPONSIBILITY TO HAVE THEIR DUES PAID TO THE CLUB IN EITHER DECEMBER OR JANUARY. MEMBERS SUBMITTING THEIR DUES AFTER THE LAST DAY OF JANUARY WILL BE SUBJECT TO A LATE FEE OF \$20.00.

IF THE DUES ARE NOT RECEIVED BY 3/31, ALL MEMBER RIGHTS **ARE ENDED** AND THE INDIVIDUAL WILL BE REQUIRED TO REAPPLY FOR MEMBERSHIP AS IF THEY WERE A NEW APPLICANT. IF A MEMBERSHIP LAPSES, (1/31 OR LATER) ALL BENEFITS END, AND ANY ACCUMULATED SHOW POINTS, DURING THE LAPSED PERIOD WILL NOT BE COUNTED TOWARD YEAR END AWARDS FROM THE 1ST OF THE YEAR TIL REINSTATEMENT.

A CHECK RECEIVED BY THE CLUB FOR DUES THAT IS RETURNED BY THE BANK FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS OR UNAVAILABLE FUNDS, WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$20.00 RETURNED CHECK FEE. MEMBERSHIP STATUS IN THIS INSTANCE WILL ALSO BE TREATED AS A LAPSE FROM THE 1ST OF THE YEAR.

FOR THOSE MEMBERS WHO DO NOT MEET THE VOLUNTEER WORK REQUIREMENT FOR THE PREVIOUS YEAR MEMBERSHIP ENDS. THE MEMBER WOULD THEN HAVE TO REAPPLY AS IF A NEW MEMBER. ALL BENEFITS FROM THE PREVIOUS MEMBERSHIP ARE DELETED.

MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

THE CLUB IS ORGANIZED AS A 501C-7 NON PROFIT CORPORATION, THE FACILITY IS OWNED BY THE MEMBERS. THE FUNDS TO MAINTAIN THE FACILITY, ITS IMPROVEMENTS AND MEMBER BENEFITS ARE DERIVED BY HORSE SHOWS AND THE RENTAL OF THE FACILITY. ALL SSBC FUNCTIONS ARE OPERATED BY MEMBER VOLUNTEERS. IT IS EACH MEMBERS RESPONSIBILITY TO HELP AT THESE FUNCTIONS TO ENSURE THE CONTINUED SUCCESS OF THE CLUB FOR ITS GUESTS AND MEMBERS.

IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO WORK DURING THE WEEKEND SHOWS, THERE ARE MANY OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE OR MAINTENANCE DUTIES THAT CAN BE PERFORMED IN LIEU OF WORKING AT THE SHOWS. PLEASE ASK A BOARD MEMBER HOW YOU CAN HELP.

ALSO, THROUGHOUT THE YEAR MEMBER WORK DAYS WILL BE SCHEDULED TO PERFORM GENERAL MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING OF THE FACILITY, YOUR SUPPORT WITH THESE DAYS IS APPRECIATED.

CLUB MANAGEMENT IS PERFORMED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS THAT CONSISTS OF SIX ELECTED OFFICERS AND 4 ELECTED DIRECTORS AND THE PAST PRESIDENT. ELECTIONS FOR THE OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS ARE HELD IN NOVEMBER WITH THE NEW BOARD TAKING EFFECT IN JANUARY. THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETS THE 2^N MONDAY OF EACH MONTH AT THE FACILITY AT 7:00 PM.

SHOW COMMITTEE: A COMMITTEE OF MEMBERS THAT OVERSEES ALL DECISIONS RELATED TO THE SSBC SHOWS. THE SHOW COMMITTEE MEETS THE LAST MONDAY OF EACH MONTH FOLLOWING THE GENERAL MEETING AT THE FACILITY. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL BE FORMED IN JANUARY WITH ACTIVE MEMBERS. A COMMITMENT FROM EACH OF THE COMMITTEE MEMBERS IS REQUIRED FOR THE ENTIRE YEAR. EACH SSBC SHOW WILL HAVE A MANAGER FROM THE SHOW COMMITTEE.

VOTING RIGHTS: TO VOTE ON ANY CLUB BUSINESS OR FOR THE ANNUAL ELECTIONS A MEMBER MUST BE ACTIVE. ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP IS OBTAINED BY ATTENDING 6 GENERAL MEETINGS AND VOLUNTEERING AT LEAST THREE HOURS AT 6 SEPARATE WORK FUNCTIONS WITHIN A YEAR. THE TIME FRAME FOR ELECTION VOTING RIGHTS IS FROM SEPT 1ST THROUGH AUGUST 31ST OF THE FOLLOWING YEAR. THE REASON FOR THIS TIME FRAME IS BECAUSE OUR BYLAWS STATE THAT THE ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP SHOULD BE OBTAINED 90 DAYS PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL ELECTIONS.

HARDSHIP EXCEPTION: A MEMBER MAY APPLY TO THE BOARD IN WRITING TO BE GRANTED A WAIVER OF THE SIX MEETING REQUIREMENT FOR ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP. THIS EXCEPTION RULE IS FOR THOSE MEMBERS WHO WORK OR ATTEND SCHOOL ON MONDAY NIGHTS AND ARE NOT ABLE TO ATTEND THE MONTHLY MEETINGS. IF THE EXCEPTION IS GRANTED FOR THE MEMBER, THE MEMBER IS REQUIRED TO SUBSTITUTE SIX WORK DAYS IN LIEU OF MEETINGS, FOR A TOTAL OF 12 WORK DAYS A YEAR, TO BE CONSIDERED AN ACTIVE MEMBER.

TO RUN FOR AN OFFICE THE MEMBER MUST BE AN ACTIVE MEMBER AND THE BYLAWS STATE THAT THE MEMBER MUST HAVE BEEN ACTIVE FOR THE PAST YEAR. THIS MEANS THAT THE MEMBER WOULD HAVE TO HAVE HAD AN ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP AS OF SEPT 1ST OF THE PRIOR YEAR.

MEMBER FACILITY RULES:

THE FACILITY IS OPEN TO USE BY THE MEMBERS ANY TIME THERE IS NOT A SCHEDULED FUNCTION. THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE TO BE ADHERED TO WHEN AT THE FACILITY DURING THIS FREE TIME:

- MEMBERS MAY RIDE IN EITHER THE COVERED OR OUTSIDE AREAS. RIDING ALONE IS NOT RECOMMENDED.
- THE ARENA MAY BE CLOSED IN THE AM FOR MAINTENANCE.
- THE ARENA MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE BEFORE A SCHEDULED EVENT IF THE ARENA *SURFACE HAS BEEN* PREPARED FOR THE EVENT.
- NON MEMBERS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS DURING FREE TIME.
- **MEMBER INSTRUCTOR'S** PROVIDING LESSONS TO OTHER MEMBERS AT THE ARENA SHOULD HAVE THEIR OWN PERSONAL INSURANCE FOR THE EXPOSURE. A COPY OF THEIR INSURANCE SHOULD BE PRESENTED TO THE CLUB PRIOR TO GIVING LESSONS. PLEASE CONTACT SANDY RAKAUSKAS WITH ANY QUESTIONS.
- NON MEMBER INSTRUCTORS MAY NOT INSTRUCT NON MEMBERS AT THE ARENA.
- IF YOU USE ANY EQUIPMENT IE, JUMPS OR BARRELS THEY MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE ARENA BEFORE YOU LEAVE.
- IF YOU USE AN OPEN STALL CLEAN IT.
- HORSES ARE NOT TO BE TURNED LOOSE IN THE ARENA.
- PLACE MANURE AND GARBAGE IN PROPER RECEPTACLES.
- EQUESTRIANS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST WEAR AN ATSM APPROVED HELMET WHILE MOUNTED ON ANY PART OF THE SILVER SANDS PREMISES.

PLEASE REMEMBER THIS IS OUR FACILITY AND WE WANT TO KEEP IT AS CLEAN AND PRESENTABLE AS WE CAN. SO WHEN YOU ARE AT THE ARENA, PLEASE TAKE THE EXTRA STEP TO PICK UP ANY LITTER THAT MAY BE LYING AROUND.

VOLUNTEERING

MEMBERS ARE ASKED TO VOLUNTEER THEIR TIME TO WORK AT THE SSBC SHOWS AND FUNCTIONS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. WE HOPE THAT EACH MEMBER WILL WORK AT LEAST SIX TIMES TO OBTAIN THEIR ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP RIGHTS. WE REALLY APPRECIATE THOSE MEMBERS WHO WORK MONTH AFTER MONTH. SSBC CURRENTLY HOLDS SHOWS ANNUALLY CONSISTING OF ENGLISH AND WESTERN PLEASURE; DRESSAGE AND DRILL TEAM. SO WE NEED ALL THE HELP WE CAN GET.

IF YOU COME TO WORK AT AN EVENT HERE ARE SOME GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW:

- SIGN IN AND OUT ON THE ROSTER FORM LOCATED IN THE REGISTRATION AREA ON THE COUNTER INSIDE OF THE DOOR. YOUR PARTICIPATION MAY NOT BE COUNTED IF YOUR NAME IS NOT ON THE ROSTER. IF YOU ARE VOLUNTEERING DURING A NON EVENT AND THERE IS NOT A SIGN IN SHEET, PLEASE EMAIL THE CLUB SECRETARY AND LET HER KNOW OF YOUR WORK HOURS.
- LET THE SHOW MANAGER KNOW YOU ARE THERE.
- WE ALL KNOW THAT EMERGENCIES ARISE AND WHEN THEY DO, PLEASE CALL THE VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR OR SHOW MANAGER IN ADVANCE AND LET THEM KNOW YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO WORK.
- WHEN YOU SHOW UP TO WORK, PLEASE DO THE JOB YOU HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED TO FOR THE FULL TIME FRAME.
- IF YOU WORK MORE THAN THREE HOURS YOU WILL RECEIVE CREDIT FOR A FREE STALL. (LIMITED TO ONE STALL CREDIT EARNED PER SHOW WORKED). THE STALL CERTIFICATE MAY BE REDEEMED AT ANY SSBC EVENT, HOWEVER, ONLY 4 OR LESS STALL CERTIFICATES MAY BE USED AT ANY ONE EVENT.
- IF YOU WORK A SHOW FROM THE START TO FINISH YOU WILL RECEIVE A WORK CERTIFICATE THAT CAN BE EXCHANGED FOR SSBC SHOW FEES OR SSBC MERCHANDISE OR SSBC CLINICS. CERTIFICATES ARE PREPARED AND HANDED OUT AT THE MONTHLY MEETINGS FOR MEMBERS THAT WORKED THAT MONTH. (MINIMUM OF AT LEAST FIVE HOURS WORKED PER SHOW; LIMITED TO ONE CERTIFICATE EARNED PER SHOW WORKED). ONLY TWO WORK CERTIFICATES MAY BE REDEEMED AT ANY ONE EVENT. MEMBERS MAY DONATE THEIR WORK CERTIFICATES TO NON RELATED YOUTH FOR SHOWING ONLY. NO OTHER SHARING OF CERTIFICATES IS ALLOWED.
- WE WOULD LIKE THE MEMBERS THAT ARE WORKING TO WEAR AN SSBC TSHIRT, HOWEVER, IT IS NOT MANDATORY. IF YOU ARE RINGSTEWARD PROPER DRESS WITH AN SSBC SHIRT IS RECOMMENDED. NO MIDDRIFT SHIRTS. PLEASE DRESS FOR SUCCESS. NEAT APPEARANCE IS NECESSARY.
- IF YOU ARE GOING TO SHOW IN A SUNDAY PLEASURE SHOW, YOU SHOULD NOT VOLUNTEER TO RINGSTEWARD ON SATURDAY.
- EACH SILVER SANDS MEMBER WORKING OR NOT, IS A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CLUB. PLEASE REMEMBER THIS WHEN TALKING AND DEALING WITH THE GUESTS/SPECTATORS/PARTICIPANTS AT OUR SHOWS.

MEMBER BENEFITS

HERE ARE A FEW OF THE MEMBER BENEFITS THAT EACH MEMBER ENJOYS:

- USE OF THE ARENAS.
- WAIVER OF STALL FEES (SEE WORKERS REQUIREMENTS FOR DETAILS)
- SHOW/CLINIC/MERCHANDISE CERTIFICATE (SEE WORKERS REQUIREMENTS FOR DETAILS)
- QUALITY CLINICS AT REDUCED RATES.
- COMMARADARIE WITH OTHER EQUESTRIANS IN ALL DISCIPLINES.
- CHRISTMAS PARTY/AWARDS PARTY.

YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

THROUGH THE GENEROSITY OF MANY, A FUND HAS BEEN SET UP TO BENEFIT THE YOUTH OF SILVER SANDS. FROM TIME TO TIME FUNDRAISERS WILL BE HELD TO FUND THIS PROGRAM THE SUPPORT OF ALL THE MEMBERS IS VITAL TO CONTINUE. THESE SCHOLARSHIPS CAN ONLY BE OFFERED AS LONG AS THERE ARE AVAILABLE FUNDS.

CURRENTLY THERE ARE TWO SEPARATE PROGRAMS:

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP:

MEMBERS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 17 AND 22 MAY APPLY UP TO TWICE A YEAR FOR A \$250.00 AWARD TO BE USED FOR COLLEGE EXPENSES. THE YOUTH MUST COMPLETE AN APPLICATION, COMPOSE AN ESSAY, AND HAVE COMPLETED 20 HOURS OF SERVICE AT SSBC EACH YEAR APPLIED. THE FUNDS WILL BE MADE PAYABLE TO THE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION.

SHOWING SCHOLARSHIP:

MEMBERS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MAY APPLY FOR FUNDS TO COMPETE IN STATE, REGIONAL OR NATIONAL SHOWS IN WHICH THEY HAVE QUALIFIED. THEY MUST COMPLETE AN APPLICATION PROCESS AND A WORK REQUIREMENT OF 10 HOURS EACH YEAR APPLIED. THE FUNDS WILL BE MADE PAYABLE TO THE EVENT.

YEAR END HIGH POINT AWARDS

IN THE BEGINNING OF THE SHOW YEAR THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL SET THE GUIDELINES FOR THE UPCOMING YEAR HIGH POINT AWARDS.

THE HIGH POINT AWARDS ARE MEANT TO GENERATE MEMBER SHOWING AND ACTIVE INVOLVEMENT IN THE CLUB. HERE ARE THE CURRENT GUIDELINES. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR HIGHPOINTS THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA MUST BE MET:

- AN ADULT MEMBER MUST HAVE OBTAINED ACTIVE STATUS SIX GENERAL MEETINGS AND SIX WORK DAYS
- A MEMBER UNDER THE AGE OF 18 DOES NOT HAVE TO BE ACTIVE.
- SAME HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION.
- HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION MUST HAVE SHOWN IN SAME DIVISION FOR PLEASURE
- IN THE QUALIFYING SHOWS THE HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION MUST HAVE SHOWN IN THE REQUIRED HIGH POINT CLASSES.
- IN DRESSAGE THE HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION MUST HAVE RIDDEN IN TWO TESTS AT THE SAME LEVEL.

SHOWING

SSBC HAS QUALIFYING RULES. SSBC RULES ARE INDICATED ON EACH SHOWBILL AND WHEN NOT INDICATED AQHA RULES ALONG WITH RANCH HORSE AND DRESSAGE FEDERATION RULES WILL THEN BE REFERRED TO.

DISCREPANCIES OR COMPLAINTS RELATED TO SHOWING SHOULD BE MADE FIRST, TO THE SHOW MANAGER OF THE DAY, AND SECONDLY TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SHOW COMMITTEE.

GENERAL FACILITY RULES

THESE RULES APPLY TO ALL MEMBERS, THEY ALSO APPLY TO NON MEMBERS. IF YOU SEE A NON MEMBER VIOLATING THESE RULES AS A MEMBER YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO NICELY REMIND THE VIOLATING PARTY OF OUR RULES.

- MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO CLEAN THEIR STALLS UNLESS THEY PAID CASH FOR THEM, NOT STALL CREDITS.
- EQUESTRIANS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST WEAR AN ATSM HELMET WHILE MOUNTED ON ANY PART OF SSBC PROPERTY.
- THE WASH RACKS ARE FOR BATHING AND GROOMING ONLY. AFTER BATHING AND GROOMING, THE HORSE SHOULD BE REMOVED FROM THE WASH RACK AREA SO OTHERS MAY USE THEM. PLEASE CLEAN THE WASH RACK AREA WHEN YOU ARE DONE.
- NO SMOKING IN THE BARN AREA.
- ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- ILLEGAL DRUGS ARE PROHIBITED.
- FIREARMS ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- SPEED LIMIT ON THE PREMISES IS 10 MPH
- SMALL CHILDREN SHOULD BE UNDER PARENT/GUARDIAN SUPERVISION AT ALL TIMES.
- DOGS SHOULD BE CONTROLLED AND LEASHED AT ALL TIMES.
- HORSES SHOULD NOT BE TIED TO ARENA FENCING OR STALL BARS.
- HORSES SHOULD NOT BE TIED AND LEFT UNATTENDED TO THE STALL RINGS ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE STALLS. THESE ARE TO BE USED FOR GROOMING/TACKING UP OR WHILE CLEANING YOUR STALL.
- TRAILERS SHOULD ONLY BE PARKED BETWEEN THE BARNs FOR LOADING AND UNLOADING PURPOSES.

- HORSES SHOULD NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN EITHER ARENA OR THE ROUND PEN.
- PLEASE PLACE ALL MANURE FREE OF HAY STRINGS AND GARBAGE IN THE MANURE SPREADERS, DO NOT PLACE MANURE IN GARBAGE RECEPTACLES.
- THIS IS A FAMILY FACILITY PLEASE REMEMBER TO WATCH YOUR *LANGUAGE!*
