NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

EXHIBITORS, THROUGH SUBMISSION OF ENTRY, ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THEY ARE KNOWLEDGEABLE OF CURRENT AAC RULES AND REGULATIONS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:

This event will be held in accordance with the current Rules and Regulations of the Agility Association of Canada (AAC) and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, pure breed or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

All dogs must have an AAC number before their entries will be accepted in an AAC sanctioned trial. Dogs with numbers pending will not be eligible to compete, except FEO. An application form for dog ID cards is available here: <http://www.aac.ca/en/Forms/Main/>.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the Rules and Regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications.

No leads, collars, food, toys or any other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Please take responsibility for your dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the trial grounds and no refund of fees shall be given.

All dogs must be penned, crated or attended on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when exiting the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out of control behavior may upon exit of the ring be disqualified and/or required to leave the trial grounds and no refund of fees shall be given.

Anyone disrupting the trial due to poor sportsmanship or abusive behavior will be dismissed from the trial and no fees will be refunded. Remember that this sport should be fun for the dogs, competitors, spectators, judges and volunteers.

LIMITED ENTRIES RULES

- 2X4 Agility reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Anyone not in good standing with AAC or 2X4 Agility will not be allowed entry.
- We are planning for approximately 200 runs/day.
- mailed - emailed or couriered entries will be accepted. Ensure that couriered entries do not require a signature
- Entries must be postmarked **Sept 11 2017** and up to and including **Sept 29, 2017**.
- Entry acceptance is **not** solely based on postmark date. Considerations for entry acceptance may include (but are not limited to): proportion of starters/advanced/masters entries, volunteer commitment at previous 2X4 events, entry acceptance at previous trials and proportion of out of town entries to local entries.

PAYMENT AND REFUNDS

- Cheques are to be made out to the **2X4 Agility** and dated not later than the closing date.
- Refunds will not be given for cancellations after the closing date *except* for bitches in season or injury to a dog, or handler, which physically prevents them from competing. **Refunds requested for any other reason will be handled on a case-by-case basis and will be at the discretion of the 2X4 Trial Committee.**
(A \$10 administration fee will be applied to any refund request received after the closing date.)
- **There will be a \$25 charge on NSF cheques.**

CLASS CHANGES

Class changes and/or withdrawals made after the closing date may not appear in the gate lists. Please make every effort to get your changes to the trial secretary ASAP. If you get a title on Saturday you may move up to the next level on Sunday (there will be **no** same day move-ups). Class Move-Up forms will be available at the Results Table. Please give them to the trial secretary **by the end of competition on Saturday.**

HEIGHT CATEGORIES AND JUMP HEIGHTS

Your dog's height category is based upon its measured height as entered on its AAC height card. Anyone wishing to run "For Exhibition Only" will be charged the same as the regular competitors. By AAC rules, you will be ineligible for placings, qualifiers or prizes. Please indicate on your entry form that you are running "FEO" and specify the division & height that you want to run your dog in. This will not be reflected on your dog's permanent record.

AGILITY CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Junior Handlers

Open to youth up to and including seventeen (17) years of age as of Jan 1st of the current year with a valid Junior Handler Number.

Regular Division

Open to all dogs, 18 months of age or older, as described within the current AAC rules

Special Division

Open to all dogs but intended for dogs, which are of a size or stature, which limits their jumping ability. Handlers running a dog in Specials will have the option to move into Regular classes once during the dog's career. Such a switch will require the handler to notify the AAC via the appropriate Regional Director (a form will be developed and available on the AAC web site), but will not require application or approval. A switch from Specials to Regular cannot be made mid-trial.

Veteran Division

For dogs seven years of age or older that are currently competing in any Standard Agility Class and for dogs five years of age or older which have competed in the Special Division for a minimum of one calendar year.

As of January 1, 2016, double drop veterans will be scored separately from single drop veterans.

FEO (For Exhibition – or Experience or Entertainment – Only) Open to all dogs, 18 months of age or older with an AAC ID #, as described within the current AAC rules. The handler can choose to enter a dog FEO in any division, any class and/or any height but they will not be competing for placements, titles or prizes and the results will not be reflected on the dog's permanent record.

PRIZES

All classes will receive flat ribbons for 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th placements and qualifying ribbons for qualifying rounds.

Title rosettes are also available for ADC, AADC, MADC, SGDC, AGDC MJDC.MGDC, MSDC. ATChC, Bronze Award of Merit, Silver Award of Merit, Gold Award of Merit and Life Time Achievement Award.

VOLUNTEER

There will be a volunteer sheet where you can sign up for your preferred jobs. Everyone is expected to volunteer at least once.

2. I agree that AAC or the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.
3. I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my "Related Parties"), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue AAC, the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of either AAC or the Organizing Club (the "Personnel") for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgment of any kind.
4. I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify and save harmless AAC, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation, lawyers' fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by AAC, the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to:
