INFORMATION

Corinth's camp is for campers going into grades 2-7. The cost of camp is \$130. The special price of \$100 will be for those who pay/register by May, 14 (for family discounts, please contact Steven Ayers). Cost of camp includes all meals (starting with dinner on Monday through breakfast on Friday morning). Each camper may want to bring spending money for drinks and snacks for the camp snack shack.

Camp this year will be held at Indian Springs State park. Indian springs is located in Flovilla, Ga, and is about an hour and a half from Corinth. The camp includes cabins, a kitchen/dinning hall, and a ball field. We have a great team of leaders and counselors this year. The ratio of adult supervision will be 1 to every 5-6 campers. Campers will leave from Corinth Monday, June 17th, at 1 PM and return Friday June 21st at 12:30 PM. Campers are expected to stay the entire camp period except for sickness or an emergency at home.
