The last couple of months have flown by! In August we were able to spend a few weeks with our sending church and get acquainted with the people there. We also had the opportunity to present our ministry at Victory Baptist Church in Whitehouse, TX. This is an exciting, young church with lots of potential. The people have such a desire to learn and grow in God's Word. We also had the opportunity to assist with a Friend Day being held there the following week. It was very exciting to see God work in many ways through this service. Several people received Christ as their personal Saviour, and a couple people were baptized. It is very exciting to see God working in this new church plant.

In September we began to travel again for several meetings in Texas. God blessed in each of these meetings, and provided our needs as we traveled. As we were part of a Missions Conference in Odessa, I had the privilege of leading our oldest daughter, Hannah to the Lord. She had made a profession of faith a few years ago, but as I spoke to her she did not remember it. So she prayed and accepted Christ as her Saviour there at the altar. It is great to know that your children have made that decision. Not based on what mom and dad say, but on what the Bible says.

We then drove to California for a Missions Conference. This conference was the first Missions Conference this church had hosted in a long time. God spared us from major disaster by allowing me to change the brakes, before the bearings seized up! Praise the Lord for one of our supporting churches that took care of all the parts for us.
