Red Lake Currant

Ribes Rubrum 'Red lake'

- Clusters of greenish-yellow flowers bloom in spring. Flowers give way to long, pendant clusters of large deep red currants which ripen in July.
- Leaves are aromatic when crushed.
- Self pollinating.
- Red currants, although tart, may be eaten ripe off the shrub, but are perhaps more often harvested to make jams, jellies and pies.
