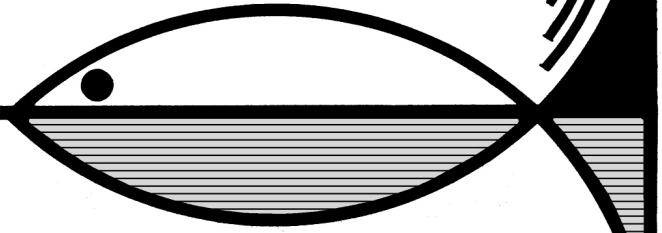

**Abstract:**

***Possibilities and Commercial Applications of Radiant Cooling, intertwined with Ventilation***
