



Dear Nursery Parent of Living Rock Church,

Welcome to the Living Rock Nursery! It is a joy for us to serve our youngest members! Our nursery volunteers strive to provide a safe and fun environment for each child who enters the nursery and as a parent/guardian, you can help us by reviewing and adhering to the following nursery guidelines.

1. For the safety of our children, we will be using a nametag number system to ensure we are giving the right child to the right family. When your child is checked in to the nursery, a tag will be placed on your child and a corresponding number tag will be given to you. In order for your child to be released at the end of the service, an adult (preferably the child's parent/guardian) must provide the corresponding tag for the nursery volunteer. **Children will not be released to siblings, even with a tag.**
2. Any child showing signs of sickness such as fever, vomiting, diarrhea, or severe rash will not be admitted into the nursery. If your child begins to show these symptoms, we will text you. If your child has been exposed to a contagious condition such as chicken pox, measles, pink eye or strep throat, please refrain from using the nursery.
3. Please **label** all of your child's items, especially sippy cups. Items left behind will be stored in the nursery for up to one week before going to Lost and Found.
4. Please refrain from checking on your child by entering the room during the service. More often than not it is upsetting to him/her and the other children. If you would like to check on your child, please use the window at the back of the nursery. If your child is considerably upset for longer than 10 minutes, we will text you. If you have special instructions for your child, please be sure to make the nursery volunteer aware of your requests.
5. If you are potty training your child you will need to take your child to the restroom before and during the services, if necessary. The nursery is only equipped to change diapers.
6. Please let nursery volunteers know if your child has any allergies and/or if snacks will be an issue for your child. All medications, including Tylenol and Ibuprofen, must be kept and administered by the child's parent/guardian.
