HERE'S THE PROJECT:

As early as 7-8 weeks into pregnancy, a heartbeat is visible via ultrasound images, and this is one of the most powerful ways we can educate women about the life of the baby they are carrying. On average, of women who might be considering abortion or even planning an abortion, 80 percent of those who consent to an ultrasound at a pregnancy resource center leave saying they plan to choose life for their unborn baby.

In 2015, Sav-A-Life Montgomery was able to provide more than 500 ultrasounds for patients with positive pregnancy tests. Would you consider helping us obtain the funding we need to provide 100 of our ultrasounds for the year ahead?
